Stephanie – how was PE uniforms handled, all MS needed to purchase? Andrea – not aware of any PE uniform payment requests. Families have reached out to Andrea separately, many waited until the last minute and places were sold out. Not sure we should promote the Foundation to pay. When parents ask for money, Principal asks the Foundation to pay. Because I think right now she thinks like Georgia said, its a bank that has money and all you need to do is ask and I hate to be the one telling them No, it doesn't run like that.

Stephanie – not sure Foundation is responsible

Georgia – Also don't feel Foundation is a catch-all for financial assistance. Parents feel this is a new item not expected at the beginning of the year.

Anastasio - have lots of apparel on campus, should use what is already there.

Andrea – feel it's worded that if parents can't do it, Foundation will pay for it. Telling her there is no money allocated for her requests. We have a budget, and can be a little flexible, but we need to stick with the budget. Maybe send her a slide slow explaining how the foundation works.

Natalie – foundation will help if that's the only option. But maybe put in parent foundation group, families reached out and need help, looking for parents to sponsor for it. Probably a lot of parents that would sponsor that don't know there is a need for that.

Georgia – use what we have, get clear list of who needs what, and make it clear we are not buying uniforms but can assist parents with sponsors. Don't have surplus of MS clothes yet in recycle clothing.

Brian – my opinion is we double our impact. Charter is for student enrichment, so subsidiing uniforms is not part of our charter. Doesn't mean we can't help. Funds to use can be justified. Recommend we stay out of this as much as possible relative to who gets what, how it's allocated – that is done at principal level. Need is brought to us relative needs of families that want to support. Families who want to support, up to \$1000, we would match that, \$100 cap per student. We don't want that to get out, but allows proceeds to be greater. I do agree, we really need to use the resources we have – have a lot of used clothes. Also match donations.

Patrick – think Andrea is closest to families and what they need. She has the meter for families who want something free, and ones who need it. Shopping difficult right after Christmas. Also, almost all kids in black pants, some in expensive ripped jeans, so vast majority of kids were wearing black pants.

Georgia – she is an OG parent who has been here from the start, fought for uniforms, got momentum for uniforms, but if no one complies, will



lose momentum. A lot of left over shirts are not printed, cost \$3 shirt to screen print them, use of shirts and become uniform shirts. Have 200 shirts left. Not sure we need all of them.

Natalie – sell or donate? Also, did volunteer to sell apparel, and we are out of sizes.

Wendy – completely out of small shirts, many students are small. Many shirts also have elementary logo. Another issue.

Georgia – motion to keep in stock popular apparel items.

Natalie – approve. Unorganized, so need to make sure it's really needed.

Andrea – table until next month. I can commit to find out exactly what we have. Will email what we have, and order by Feb. Believe we should order more. Even though the MS students don't like the logo, they do like the circle logo.

Leane – motion to approve once have inventory determined.

Georgia – 1st

Anastasio - 2nd

All approve.

Brian – in favor, and whatever in excess, don't order more of.

Anasatsio – need to get into leadership class, two full closests of apparel in there.

Andrea – 95% out of t-shirts, mostly sweatshirts left. Tshirts gone in first 3 days, lots of sweaters. Really need tshirts.

Patrick and Natalie can assist with going through inventory.

Anastasio – have red bins, can access to help organize

Andrea - Great, raised over \$12,000. Problem that no one else was notified, principal out of loop who was organizing, next time we should have approval from principal first and get staff member involved. A lot of miscommunications. Happy to work with her, but need to keep everyone in the loop. A lot of the posts on parent square have to be approved before they are sent out. Valentine online and in store only. Leane — online easier, ships directly to you. Option to do both.

Patrick – shipping fee?

Natalie – she doesn't do it that way b/c puts burdeon of shipping on families. Not sure if there is an option to do both. Also better price if submits order all at once. Order online may reduce profits. One giant order, we get a better cut.

Anastasio – easy fundraiser, not a lot of work to be done. I expect it now, Christmas order sees candy, now expecting Valentines. If option to



do both, that might be useful. If needs to be approved by principal, then we need to run it by her.

Georgia – MS kids more into valentine

Anastasio – leadership, new VP came in, presented to leadership class do a valentine gram. Huge price difference in leadership class. Need to leave fundraising ideas open to assist MS program.

Georgia – agree should continue sees candy. If kids want to do something in addition, that would be great. Sounds like we just need to notify principal early.

Patrick – we are saying it's easy, but that's b/c a certain amount of work was dumped on andrea and office staff

Natalie – Elizabeth does put a lot of work into it (she's a parent)

Andrea – having a committee and one staff member to support would be useful. I got a lot of emails, wrong boxes, have to contact Eliazabeth. Don't mind Christmas one next school year, Feb one is a lot with the testing. If another staff member in office could take that on, would be idea. If don't have another staff member, have same issues have now. Don't know what to do if Elizabeth not there.

Wendy - FYI, Monday on campus, was told I can't sell apparel b/c during work hours, should be foundation member, mentioned I am a member, but that was pointed out

Andrea – bothers me, b/c they are always asking the Foundation to pay for things, but you can't allow us fundraise

Wendy – foundation is part of school, enrichment, little upset also Brian – school is not going to manage that, if you don't want us to be involved in uniforms, then you manage it. And the Foundation is not the schools checkbook. Agree with Andrea. Without the Foundatino, school would be limping around pretty poor not supporting a lot of programs. Don't want you to get trouble at work, but need to find out how to make that point.

Wendy – have to understand what the Foundation is. Have to have more knowledge.

Brian – easy to do. Foundation is for student enrichment, and anything that has to do with student enrichment.

Wendy – told them that, that Foundation supported me a lot for the clubs I was managing

Brian – and if you need talking points, happy to provide. Not-for-profit separate organization

Anastasio – next coffee chat, Foundatino need to have a presentation, and we need to invite families that are not here tonight. Should go out on parentsquare, be transparent. Feel like it's the same parents do this, and we need more volunteers.



Georgia – some of the things that they ask donna to do shocks me, go to for stuff off the charts, incrediblty giving, now pattern has gotten established, so maybe we need to clarify some boundaries, she is represented as a parent and a foundation

Brian – Donna needs to do that

Georgia – summary, need more volunteers to help with Sees, parents and a staff person.

Patrick – can we get leadership class to help with distribution in turn for a cut of the proceeds?

Anastasio -now permanent teacher, more time, can present that to them, great idea

Natalie – distribution a couple of hours between couple parents, most of work done by Elizabeth behind the scenes, not sure about distribution, how much work is needed

Georgia – Feb event, need to decide now

Natalie – shipping to houses in Feb?

Brian – don't see why we just take it out of everyone hands and order online

Anastasio – that's what this is about
